Parent / Student Acknowledgement and Consent Form

The form must be signed and returned to Mountain Kids within 3 days of enrollment, or prior to your students first day of Camp.

- I Agree:** Acceptable Use and Network Policies: I accept and agree with Mountain Kids use and network policies. I understand and agree that by giving my child an internet connected device, the ultimate responsibility for what my child has access to on the internet is my own.
- I Agree:** Bring Your Own Device Policy: I give my child permission to use his or her internet enabled device(s) for instructional use in their e-learning or virtual classes, while at Mountain Kids under Mountain Kids care. I understand and agree Mountain Kids is not responsible for the loss or damage (physical or data), nor the content of this device.
- I Agree:** Covid 19 Risk and Release: I understand COVID19 has a long incubation period during which a person may be a carrier of the disease but show no symptoms. I understand it is impossible to determine who has or does not have COVID19, given the current limitations and availability of COVID19 testing. I understand because COVID19 is an airborne disease, there is a risk of contracting it simply by entering the premises of Mountain Kids Louisville, LLC.

On behalf of myself and the minor children and others in my party, I voluntarily assume the substantial and significant risk of serious harm that may be associated with entering and using the premises and with attending and participating in activities at Mountain Kids Louisville, LLC. I agree to accept sole responsibility for any illness, injury, or expense of any kind that may result and to hold Mountain Kids Louisville, LLC harmless from any claim, expense, or liability arising from the same.

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Your Families Commitment and Standards

As a parent in the Camp program, your role in our health and risk management is critical. Before you send your child to our program, and throughout their term with us, you must ensure that our health form is completed daily and accurately. The safety of our staff and students depends on our parents keeping children with any visible sign of illness, fever, shortness of breath, new loss of taste or smell, diarrhea, sore throat, vomiting, cough, headache, runny nose home.

Consent to Contact and Information Disclosure

In order to effectively and efficiently ensure your student is completing and progressing in their school work we will make every effort to communicate directly with you regarding all aspects of your child's learning. However, ultimately it will be up to the family to check in with their student to confirm their child is completing assignments on-time, and attending all required lectures.

In addition, regardless of your child's age Mountain Kids will need to know all of their log in credentials and any other individualized information that is required to ensure they can connect to and properly complete their e-learning and assignments. We will keep all of this information confidential and in your student's file. It is the parents responsibility to update us with any log in information, including password changes.

Student Policies

Introduction

Our faculty will work hard to support, motivate and encourage your student(s), however, ultimately their success will depend on their commitment to their remote learning responsibilities.

Student Dress Code

Comfortable active clothing that allows for movement education, park play and of course remote learning.

Network Policies

- Use of the Mountain Kids network in such a way that it disrupts the use of the network is prohibited.
- Students must always follow any teacher guidelines and instructions on appropriate use of the network.
- Cyberbullying of any form will not be tolerated.
- Off-task behaviors are not allowed.
- Accessing inappropriate content is strictly prohibited.

Internet Acceptable Use

Students will only have access to course related materials for education purposes. Use of the internet for any other purpose will not be allowed.

Disclaimer of Connection Responsibility

Mountain Kids Louisville makes no warranties of any kind for the provided internet access. We will make every effort to have acceptable high performance internet connectivity. However, Mountain Kids Louisville will not be held responsible for the inability to connect or utilize our network for the following reasons: service provider interruption, device incompatibility, school provided malfunction, device function or power issues, inclement weather or power outages, application or device troubleshooting, any other cause outside of our control. Refunds will not be issued simply because your student was unable to connect to the internet.

Bring Your Own device Policy

Students are required to bring their own device to connect to and successfully complete their remote learning. These devices may be a personal one, or provided by the student's school/district. Students must assume all responsibility for their devices. Mountain Kids Louisville is not responsible for the security of any device.

Students must ensure their devices do not disrupt the learning of others, violate anyone's privacy, or be involved in any inappropriate conduct.

Disclaimer of Content Accessibility

While Mountain Kids Louisville will make every reasonable effort to preclude access to the parts of the internet that are inappropriate for our students, it is not possible to perfectly prevent such access when a device has internet connection. Indeed, inappropriate content can be brought in on a digital device manually with no internet connection involved.

Students may use their own personal devices during their scheduled free time for non-academic purposes, but just as with their academic devices, if a parent provides their child with an internet connected device, certain risks regarding this reserves the right to remove a student from the program should their actions on any device violate the handbook or be used to access or distribute inappropriate content.

Our responsibility at Camp Home Learning is to cooperatively work with parents, educators and families to teach healthy habits, reinforce our content policies, and supervise students as well as reasonably possible in a classroom setting.

Technology Maintenance and Responsibility

Students are responsible for the care of all supplies and technology that they bring to Camp Home Learning. Please help them remember to charge their devices each night. Mountain Kids Louisville is not responsible for any damages to devices, including loss of data.

Printing and Other Office Supply Needs

All students are required to provide their own print copies of any documents that they can't view or work on digitally.

What you Bring to Camp Home Learning

Technology

- A device suitable for connection and use with their virtual and e-learning classes.
- A good pair of headphones - noise canceling headphones recommended
- Fully charged device each day (remember to charge it each night)
- All cords, chargers, and / or adapters needed to connect and charge their device.

Important log-in, user name, passwords and details

- Class Schedule
- Username / Password - all log-in credentials
- Details and log-in information for all websites, e-learning platforms, apps needed to complete school work

School Supplies

- 1-2 Books to read during literacy time every day!
- Paper, notebooks
- Pencils, Pens, and any other writing utensil they may need.
- Special supplies for specific projects, homework ie: poster board etc.

Other Items

- Lunch, two snacks, reusable water bottle
- Medications Needed
- Daily Homework Folder

Health Items

- Required medical forms if necessary
- Medications needed (must be signed in with our staff)

Administrative Policies

- ❑ **Weekly Payment Schedule:** tuition is due on Monday one full week prior to each week of Camp Home Learning.
- ❑ **Changes and Cancelations:** Schedule changes and cancelations must be made **by the Monday one full week prior** to the week you wish to cancel/change and submitted via email to camp@mountainkidsloisville.com. Changes will be accepted as space allows.
- ❑ **Deposits:** \$50 weekly deposit is non-refundable and non-transferable at anytime*
- ❑ Make-ups are not offered for absences, and no part of the camp fee is refundable/transferable for absences.
- ❑ **Covid-related Cancelations / Quarantines:** In order to abide by the guidelines provided to us by CDPHE and BCPH, students may be prevented from attending Camp Home Learning due to various covid19 related risk factors or exposure.

We are unable to offer refunds due to covid related cancelations or mandatory quarantines.

- ❑ **Lost Items and Security:** Mountain Kids is not responsible for any item brought into or left at the facility at any time. We do have a lost and found on site, which is frequently donated. Students will be responsible for keeping up with their personal belongings, with the help and support of our staff.
